CSC set records last year with increased emergency aid spending, meal provision, and Christmas family support. The rising cost of living and seasonal employment challenges contributed to these figures. (see statistics boxes inside)

Our Blossoms of Hope fundraiser exceeded \$400,000 again this year, for which we are thankful to sponsors Wildflowers Boutique and Perdido Beach Resort, as well as the Cromeans Foundation. We are blessed with incredibly strong community support.

In December, site work began for our new Food Pantry storage building, which will enable us to take advantage of sales and bulk purchases, as well as store community-provided food and seasonal projects.

The new year brings an exciting opportunity: a second CSC location opening in Orange Beach. We will partner with Worship on the Water to allow us to meet with our OB clients at their new outreach location and to help establish a food pantry there. This proposal was approved by the CSC Executive Board and the Advisory Board.

More details will follow as talks continue and progress is made.

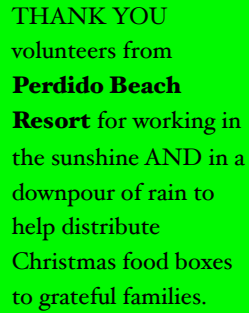

CLIENTS WE SEE...

The single mom with two children whose job was just cut. She has a new job but won't get paid for two weeks, so she is short on rent and needs food.

The couple who can't pay the power bill because it took all they could come up with, after the rent, to get their car fixed.

The man whose doctor wants him to see a specialist in Mobile, but he can't afford the gas for the trip, and can't make the copay on his prescriptions.

The homeless veteran who is living in his car and is hungry.

The elderly couple living on social security whose rent has gone up each of the last three years. They struggle and have to juggle which bills get paid on time. Now one of them is sick and the car has broken down.

This is just a sampling of the clients we see and the difficulties they face. These are real people, and we were able to help each of them with their immediate needs — and we were often able to make referrals to other agencies as well to further assist them.
